Inspection Report of the Divisional Forest Officer Kasaragod at Balavanthadukka <u>- Pandi Road</u>

The road is situating Delampady Grama Panchayath connecting Balavanthadukka Pandi around 950 meters Forest Land going through Bandadukka Reserve Forest area of 0.294 Ha. I have inspected the site on 03.12.2019 for developing the road as requested by the user agency It is seen this there is no need to cut and remove trees. This road not includes in the working plan. This road is primarily maintained by Forest Department.

This road is being using about 400 Nos of peoples residing nearly especially colony of tribes. There is SC colony and ST colony. These colony have only this road for going to hospitals, schools and Gov. institutions.

<u>Recommendation of the Divisional Forest Officer Kasaragod -Balavanthadukka -</u> <u>Pandi Road</u>

The proposal of the Secretary Delampady Grama Panchayath for seeking permission to construct Balavandadukka – Pandi road through Bandadukka Reserve Forest is to provide road connectivity to SC colony. Balavandadukka – Pandi area is in Kasaragod Forest Division. The extend of land to be diverted is 0.294 Ha. Since there is no other means to construct road other than a Forest land. The proposal is submitted for approval.

Inspection Report of the Divisional Forest Officer Kasaragod – Construction of Vellarikkaya colony Bridges

The proposal site of construction of Vellarikkaya colony bridge is situating Delampady Grama Panchayath. The bridge is to be construct across Pallanchi river in Bandadukka Reserve Forest using 0.0063Ha. I have inspected the site on 03.12.2017, for the construction of bridge as requested by the user agency it is seen that there is no need to cut and removal of trees.

After construction of this bridge it will use full 18 Nos of ST family including School students.
