The under signed inspected the sites, along with Mumbai Railway Vikas Corporation (MRVC) representative on 12/02/2019 and 24/12/2019. This project involves a total of 9.1321 Ha. of forest area (Reserve Forest, acquired forest and private forest). Required to be diverted for Doubling Railway Line of this railway having length of 29.60 Km. Which passes through forest Villages Belavali, Bhingar, Barvai, Bherale Tal. Panvel, Lodhivli, Vavarle, Tal. Khalapur and Kiravali Vanjale, Tal. Karjat, Raigad District.

From the site inspection it appears that, there is some cutting of trees is to be required for proposed non-forest activities and work has not been started in forest areas.
