

Inspection notes of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam on the proposal received from the User Agency i.e., Executive Engineer, Panchayat Raj Division, Paderu for diversion of 2.89 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from G.Agraharam road to Lakkavaram of G.K.Veedhi Mandal on 22.05.2018.



Inspected the proposed area for diversion of 2.89 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from G.Agraharam road to Lakkavaram of G.K.Veedhi Mandal passing through Pedavalasa R.L. of R.V.Nagar Range on 22.05.2018 along with staff of Forest Department and Panchayat Raj Division, Paderu. As per the DGPS Survey the proposed road starts with GPS readings

N:17.81751334, E.82.19490030 and ends at **N:17.83363155, E.82.18364503**. The proposed road width is 6 m. and out of 5,960 m. of total length of the road, 4,8166.66 m. length with a width of 6.00 m. is passing through Compt. no.1324, 1325, 1329 & 1488 of Pedavalasa R.L. with a diversion of 2.89 ha. The density of the forest on the proposed road width is less as there is already an existing cart road/ pathway of width about 4 m. There are 18 Non-teak trees to be removed/ permitted to removed for laying the proposed road and the details of which are enclosed. The density of the forest in the nearby vicinity of the proposed road is > 0.8. The proposed road is very essential to tribal villages/ hamlets for their connectivity and essential services like medical facilities, education, marketing of agricultural produce etc. In the inspected area the User agency did not carry out any work in violation of the provisions of FC Act, 1980 and other relevant acts. The required forest area is unavoidable for the project and due to this project there is no threat to the local flora, fauna and there is no archeological heritage importance in this locality.
