FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF DISTRICT FOREST OFFICER, RANGAREDDY IN TUMMALUR RESERVE FOREST ON 27.03.2022

I have inspected the proposed area for Access of Existing road from Srisailam highway to Lemoor village for transporting the farm produce to the market and daily needs in Tummalur RF, along with the Forest Divisional Officer, Shamshabad and concerned staff of Mankhal Range on 27.03.2022.

The proposed forest land situated in the Compt. Nos. 330 of Tumallur RF Mankhal Range of Shamshabad Division of Rangareddy District with the density of 0.0 to 0.4. The proposed road for diversion in length of 1079.70 mtrs and with a width of 9.00 mts passing through Tummalur Reserve Forests, there are 231 trees existing in the proposed area and all the trees are enumerated. I have test checked the enumeration list and found correct.

Further it is stated that the proposed road for diversion passing through the Tumulur Reserve Forests block of Mankhal Range of Shsmshabad Division, The Tumallur Forest Block has already been protected with CPT with stabilized mound. During enquiry with the staff, the fauna present in the area consists of mostly Wild Bores of Schedule (III) animals of Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, which are not endangered. The total area comes to 0.9717 Ha.
