- 2.0 The proposed project is construction of coastal road from jalmarg sector-16 Kharghar to Sector-11 in CBD Belapur and Balance Link Transport Terminal in Nerul Mumbai in Thane and Raigad District in the State of Maharashtra. The proposed coastal road has been divided into two parts-I is construction of coastal road from sector 11 CBD, Belapur to Jalmarg sector No.16, Kharghar (Raigad District) and Part-II is construction of balance line of coastal road from Sector 15 at CBD, Belapur to Passenger Water Transport Terminal in Nerul (Thane District). The Benefit of proposed area is shown as under:-
 - ➤ CIDCO has prepared Navi Mumbai development plan which covers 95 villages and 14 well plan and self-sustained Nodes viz. Airoli, Ghansoli, Koparkhairane Vashi, Sanpada, Nerul, Belapur, Kharghar, Kamothe, Kalamboli, New Panvel, Ulwe, Pushapak Nagar and Dronagiri.
 - ➤ Initially CIDCOs focus of development was in Vashi, Sanpada, CBD, Koparkhairane and Airoli and this node were developed completely in 1990 and subsequently handed over to Navi Mumbai Municipal corporation in than year 1994. This part of Navi Mumbai is referred to as Navi Mumbai (North).
 - ➤ Thereafter, upon arrival Harbor Railway line which is extension from Mankhurd to New Panvel in 1990 there was tremendous increase in population in Navi Mumbai when CIDCO had to shift it's devolvement focus to other to Nodes like Kharghar, Kamothe, Kalamboli, New Panvel, Ulwe and Dronagiri. These Nodes come under Raigad district are now referred as Navi Mumbai (South) which is under CIDCO's jurisdiction.
 - Kharghar Node is located below forest land which is beautifully planned node of CIDCO and termed as to be most modern and Iconic node of CIDCO. Kharghar is primarily as residential township and having several education institutes in its fold as per present status of development sector 1 to 22 in this node are fully developed. Except sector 9 which is surrounding Kopara village and yet another development other sector like 26 to 45 are still under development the pace of development in these sector is now picked up.
 - This node also has CIDCO housing project such as Spagheti, Gharkul, Vastu Vihar Celebration, Valley Shilp and Swapnapurti constructed by CIDCO for various categories (EWS, LIG and MIG) of population. CIDCO has taken up the PMAY housing scheme in sector No.40 and at Pendhar Taloja within Kharghar Node Kharghar has also encompasses Kharghar Valley Golf Course as well as Central Park which are other iconic project of CIDCO.

- An International Standard Corporate Park in line with BKC Mumbai has also been planned of an area of 120 ha. Sector 28 to 31 of this node.

4.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag Forest Division, Alibag and Divisional Forest Officer, Mumbai Mangrove Conservation Unit have certified that:-

- 4.1 Total non forest land involved in the project is 26.8676 ha. (P/18).
- 4.2 The cross section map is enclosed herewith on Page No.269.
- 4.3 The copy of the Administrative approval accorded by the Superintending Engineer, Vashi vide letter dated 18/02/2019 is enclosed on page No.144
- 4.4 (i) The site inspection report of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag Forest Division Alibag is enclosed herewith on page No.41 to 43.
 - (ii) The site inspection report of the Divisional Forest Officer, Mumbai Mangrove Conservation Unit is enclosed herewith on page No.47 to 50.
- 4.5 (i) No alternate alignment is possible and the forest land required is lowest minimum.(P/21)
 - (ii) No alternate alignment is possible and the forest land required is barest minimum (P/22)
- 4.6 (i) The area belongs to Eco-value class-II having density is 0.3 (P/32)
 - (ii) The area belongs to Eco-value class-II having density is 0.3 to 0.4 (P/33)
- 4.7 There are 1182 trees of various species and trees involved in implementation of the project. The Girth wise break up is as under:- (P/34 & P/35) (P/98 & P/129)

- 4.8 The area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc. (P/30 & 31)
- 4.9 Proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance. (P/28,29)

- 4.10 There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. (P/23,24)
- 4.11 (i) The proposed project is about 13.50 Km. from Karnala Bird Sanctuary and 6.200 Km. from the boundary of the Eco-Sensitive Zone of Karnala Bird Sanctuary (P/36)
 - (ii) The proposed project is 9.350 Km from nearest boundary of Thane Creek Flamingo Sanctuary (P/31)
- 4.12 Proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 9.00 ha. degraded forest land in compartment No.216, Survey No.283 Pt. at Village Vani (Goyandawadi), Taluka Roha, Dist.Raigad is contiguous & suitable for afforestation and management purpose, it is also free from encroachment and encumbrances. (P/25)
- 4.13 The non-forest area covered under the project is not under the provision of Maharashtra Private Forest (Acquisition) Act 1975 by virtue of application of Section 35 of Indian Forest Act 1927 and are not recognized as deemed reserved forest as well as not included in the area identified as "forest" as per dictionary meaning of forest as intimated to the expert committee appointed under interim judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996. (P/26, 27)
- 4.14 The proposed alignment is best suitable from forestry point of view. (P/38,39)
- 5.0 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking that:-
- 5.1 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Net Present Value. (P/139)
- 5.2 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Compensatory Afforestation (P/137).
- 5.3 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking regarding the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been applied and is under process and shall be submitted before final approval as per Government of India vide letter No.11-43/2013-FC, dt. 3/12/2018. (P/258)
- 6.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag Forest Division, Alibag and Divisional Forest Officer, Mumbai Mangrove Conservation Unit, Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, Mangrove Cell, Mumbai and Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Thane and have recommended the proposal for diversion of 8.2222 ha. of forest land (P/3 to 5, 6 to 8, 9&9A)
- 2.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: –

- 2.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.
- 2.2 Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.

2.3 Compensatory Afforestaton:-

- a) Compensatory afforstation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 9.00 ha. degraded forest land in compartment No.216, Survey No.283 Pt. at Village Vani (Goyandawadi), Taluka Roha, Dist.Raigad at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- 2.4 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

2.5 NPV:-

- a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 8.2222 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
- b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- 2.6 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 2.7 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (http://parivesh.nic.in/).
- 2.8 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector before Stage-II approval.

- 2.9 User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per the IRC norms.
- 2.10 Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/Forest Areas.
- 2.11 It Shall be mandatory to provide underpass for safe crossing of wild animals:-
 - (a) The underpass shall have a minimum size of width 4.00 mt and Height 3.00 mt.
 - (b) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence, then no need to construct new underpass subject to existing structure nearly complying above mentioned dimensions, as suggested in (a) above.
 - (c) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence but as per engineering requirement, it is required to reconstruct then that structure shall comply with the minimum dimensions as suggested in (a) above.
 - (d) Interval between such underpasses shall not be more than 2.00 km
- 2.12 The user agency shall provide suitable under/over pass in Protected Area/ Forest Area as per recommendation of CWLW/NBWL/FAC/REC.
- 2.13 User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
- 2.14 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government
- 2.15 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land
- 2.16 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 2.17 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 2.18 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 2.19 The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
- 2.20 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal
- 2.21 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstance be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.

- 2.22 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 2.23 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- 2.24 The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/)

3.00 It is therefore, requested that Government of Maharashtra may kindly recommended the proposal for approving for diversion of 8.2222 ha. Forest land under section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of coastal road from jalmarg sector-16 Kharghar to Sector-11 in CBD Belapur and Balance Link Transport Terminal in Nerul Mumbai in Thane and Raigad District in the State of Maharashtra under section 2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

3.0 The proposed project is construction of coastal road from jalmarg sector-16 Kharghar to Sector-11 in CBD Belapur and Balance Link Transport Terminal in Nerul Mumbai in Thane and Raigad District in the State of Maharashtra. The proposed coastal road has been divided into two parts-I is construction of coastal road from sector 11 CBD, Belapur to Jalmarg sector No.16, Kharghar (Raigad District) and Part-II is construction of balance line of coastal road from Sector 15 at CBD, Belapur to Passenger Water Transport Terminal in Nerul (Thane District). The Benefit of proposed area is shown as under:-

- CIDCO has prepared Navi Mumbai development plan which covers 95 villages and 14 well plan and self-sustained Nodes viz. Airoli, Ghansoli, Koparkhairane Vashi, Sanpada, Nerul, Belapur, Kharghar, Kamothe, Kalamboli, New Panvel, Ulwe, Pushapak Nagar and Dronagiri.
- ➤ Initially CIDCOs focus of development was in Vashi, Sanpada, CBD, Koparkhairane and Airoli and this node were developed completely in 1990 and subsequently handed over to Navi Mumbai Municipal corporation in than year 1994. This part of Navi Mumbai is referred to as Navi Mumbai (North).



- ➤ Thereafter, upon arrival Harbor Railway line which is extension from Mankhurd to New Panvel in 1990 there was tremendous increase in population in Navi Mumbai when CIDCO had to shift it's devolvement focus to other to Nodes like Kharghar, Kamothe, Kalamboli, New Panvel, Ulwe and Dronagiri. These Nodes come under Raigad district are now referred as Navi Mumbai (South) which is under CIDCO's jurisdiction.
- ➤ Kharghar Node is located below forest land which is beautifully planned node of CIDCO and termed as to be most modern and Iconic node of CIDCO. Kharghar is primarily as residential township and having several education institutes in its fold as per present status of development sector 1 to 22 in this node are fully developed. Except sector 9 which is surrounding Kopara village and yet another development other sector like 26 to 45 are still under development the pace of development in these sector is now picked up.
- This node also has CIDCO housing project such as Spagheti, Gharkul, Vastu Vihar Celebration, Valley Shilp and Swapnapurti constructed by CIDCO for various categories (EWS, LIG and MIG) of population. CIDCO has taken up the PMAY housing scheme in sector No.40 and at Pendhar Taloja within Kharghar Node Kharghar has also encompasses Kharghar Valley Golf Course as well as Central Park which are other iconic project of CIDCO.
- ➤ An International Standard Corporate Park in line with BKC Mumbai has also been planned of an area of 120 ha. Sector 28 to 31 of this node.

- (ii) The area belongs to Eco-value class-II having density is 0.3 to 0.4 (P/33)

- 4.8 The area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc. (P/30 & 31)
- 4.9 Proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance. (P/28,29)
- 4.10 There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. (P/23,24)
- 4.11 (i) The proposed project is about 13.50 Km. from Karnala Bird Sanctuary and 6.200 Km. from the boundary of the Eco-Sensitive Zone of Karnala Bird Sanctuary (P/36)
 - (ii) The proposed project is $9.350~\mathrm{Km}$ from nearest boundary of Thane Creek Flamingo Sanctuary (P/31)
- 4.12 Proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 9.00 ha. degraded forest land in compartment No.216, Survey No.283 Pt. at Village Vani (Goyandawadi), Taluka Roha, Dist.Raigad is contiguous & suitable for afforestation and management purpose, it is also free from encroachment and encumbrances. (P/25)
- 4.13 The non-forest area covered under the project is not under the provision of Maharashtra Private Forest (Acquisition) Act 1975 by virtue of application of Section 35 of Indian Forest Act 1927 and are not recognized as deemed reserved forest as well as not included in the area identified as "forest" as per dictionary meaning of forest as intimated to the expert committee appointed under interim judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996. (P/26, 27)
- 4.14 The proposed alignment is best suitable from forestry point of view. (P/38,39)

- 6.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag Forest Division, Alibag and Divisional Forest Officer, Mumbai Mangrove Conservation Unit, Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, Mangrove Cell, Mumbai and Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Thane and have recommended the proposal for diversion of 8.2222 ha. of forest land (P/3 to 5, 6 to 8, 9 & 9 A)
- 2.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: –
- 2.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.
- 2.2 Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.

2.3 Compensatory Afforestaton:-

- a) Compensatory afforstation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 9.00 ha. degraded forest land in compartment No.216, Survey No.283 Pt. at Village Vani (Goyandawadi), Taluka Roha, Dist.Raigad at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.

- 2.6 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 2.7 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (http://parivesh.nic.in/).
- 2.8 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector before Stage-II approval.
- 2.9 User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per the IRC norms.
- 2.10 Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/Forest Areas.
- 2.11 It Shall be mandatory to provide underpass for safe crossing of wild animals:-
 - (a) The underpass shall have a minimum size of width 4.00 mt and Height 3.00 mt.
 - (b) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence, then no need to construct new underpass subject to existing structure nearly complying above mentioned dimensions, as suggested in (a) above.
 - (c) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence but as per engineering requirement, it is required to reconstruct then that structure shall comply with the minimum dimensions as suggested in (a) above.
 - (d) Interval between such underpasses shall not be more than 2.00 km
- 2.12 The user agency shall provide suitable under/over pass in Protected Area/ Forest Area as per recommendation of CWLW/NBWL/FAC/REC.
- 2.13 User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
- 2.14 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government
- 2.15 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land
- 2.16 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 2.17 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 2.18 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.

- 2.19 The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
- 2.20 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal
- 2.21 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstance be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
- 2.22 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 2.23 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- 2.24 The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/)
- 3.0 Keeping in view facts mentioned in above para this proposal for proposal for diversion of 8.2222 ha. Forest land under section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of coastal road from jalmarg sector-16 Kharghar to Sector-11 in CBD Belapur and Balance Link Transport Terminal in Nerul Mumbai in Thane and Raigad District in the State of Maharashtra is recommended for approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
