13) Specific recommendation of DCF for acceptance or Otherwise of proposal with reasons.

The proposal is recommended for acceptance; as the proposed Forest lands is use for laying of underground OFC duct & cable within ROW of existing road

passing through forest land in Devli, Zanzwad, Dudgaon, Goroshi, Shiravli, Dudhoshi, Parpar & Kumbhroshi, Tal. - Mahabaleshwar, Dist. Satara. The road selected as the maximum area will be covered for mobile network and easy maintain for long period.

Proposal is recommended for C.A. may not be levied to this proposal, as proposal for laying underground OFC, within RoW of existing road MDR 17, Area not falling in N.P. & WL. Sanctuary, & there is no need of felling of trees. (Fulfil the conditions laid by MoEF guideline FC- 11/165/2019 Dt 27/07/2020) P. A. will start work after sanction by State Govt.

There is no alternative non-forest land available, and the area is to be diverted is not sensitive and hence will not have any adverse effect on the ecology of area. Hence this proposal is recommended for diversion of the forest land for laying underground OFC Cable.
