SITE INSPECTION REPORT

The proposed site for diversion of 3.862 hectares of Forest land in Swamymalai(SM) Block, Near Ranjithpura, Sandur Taluk, Ballari District for Access Road to Mining Lease No.2245 [C-category mines; erstwhile lessee M/s. Bharath Mines and Minerals and FC transferred in favour M/s.Kirloskar Ferrous Industries Limited was inspected personally by me on 02nd August, 2023.

The proposed forest area falls in Swamymalai Forest Block, Sandur South Range, Ballari District which is having Southern Dry Deciduous Type of Forest (Eco- class III - Dense Forest). Village and Survey number wise details of the proposed Area for diversion are as following;
