A proposal has been received by this office from Additional District Magistrate, Cum Deputy Director (Admin) AIIMS. District Bilaspur for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 40.5084 ha. of forest land for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for **construction of AIIMS at Kothipura in favour of ADM-cum-Dy. Director (Admin)**. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated **23.10.2018**.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring 40.5084 ha.
