

JOINT SITE INSPECTION REPORT

A proposal has been submitted under the Indian Forest Conservation Act-1980 for use of forest land for non-forestry purposes. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Construction of Approach road with Avalanches Protection Works from Z-Morh Tunnel East Portal to Zojilla Tunnel West Portal in Comptt. 63(a)/Sindh Kullian Block by National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL).

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by from 12-09-2020 upto 21-09-2020.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest land measuring 49.5904 Hacs.

Col. 7 (xi). Yes, the area inhabits some unique species of medicinal plants like Sauseria, Podophyllum, Adiantum and high altitude species of Betulla and Fir. Some unique Faunal species like Himalayan Brown Bear, Musk Deer etc are also found in and around the sanctuary. Since the project is linear and also adjacent to the already existing National Highway (Srinagar-Ladakh), it may not have such severe effect on these species individually, however the better observations in this regard can be had from the Wild Life Department.

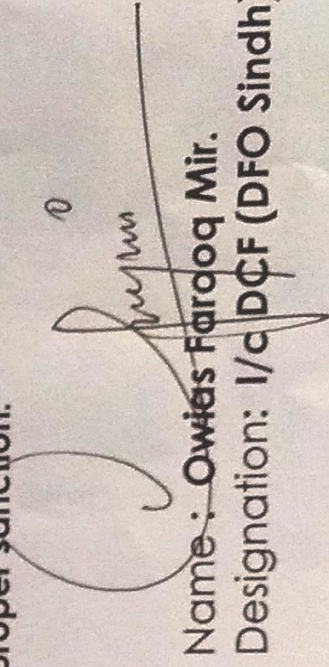
Col.7 (xii). No archaeological/heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.
