

FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, ASIFABAD (FAC) IN ASIFABAD DIVISION

Today on **17.06.2020** inspected the proposed diversion area for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way in favour of M/s Vindhya Telelinks Limited, Secuderabad in Asifabad Forest Division along with concerned staff. As per the field verification, the proposed Optical Fiber Cable line along the road is passing through the following Reserve Forest, the details are as follows.

The proposed diversion area is passing through Kunchavelly RF in Rebbena Range, the length is 2380 meters with a width of 0.40 meters which is amounting to the total area, required for diversion in Rebbena Range of Asifabad Division is **0.0952 Ha** and remaining area passing through outside Reserve Forest i.e, length 58.15 mtrs with a width of 0.40 meters and the area is 0.0023 ha.



In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree is found, no protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is found in the area. The proposed area is not falling in National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere reserve, Tiger reserve, Elephant corridor, etc. There is no tree growth existing on the proposed diversion area, as it is passing along the road.

The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project. No violation against the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency.

Hence it is recommended for considering the proposal.
