The FRL of Malkapet Reservoir (package – IX) is 432.5 mts and that of Ananthagiri Reservoir is 397.0mts.

		Hence the user agency is requested to take up suitable slope stability measures keeping in view of the stability of total hilly areas as the areas proposed are under submergence and simultaneously, the suitable afforestation activities are also proposed in the remaining forest areas in CA- Scheme in detail.

Specific recommendation of the Deputy Conservator of Forest for acceptance or other wise of the proposal with reasons.	<p>It is submitted that, the proposal consists of diversion of 445.9565ha of Forest land in Rajanna Siricilla district in two packages, i.e. Package – IX and Package – X. The details are as follows:</p> <p>Package – IX: This Package consists of diversion of 329.1385ha of Forest land in Rajanna Siricilla district. The detailed inspection note is enclosed here with.</p> <p>Package – X: - This package consists of proposed diversion of 116.818 ha in Anantahram-III & V forest blocks. The forest is of open with canopy density from 0.1 to 0.3. The cost involved is Rs.2715.35 crores. The detailed inspection note is enclosed here with.</p> <p>The Kaleswaram project is envisaged to convey water to the command area spread over in 13 districts of Telanagana state for irrigating ayacut of 18,25,700 acres and providing drinking water facility to the cities of Hyderabad & Secunderabad and enroute villages being executed in (28) packages.</p> <p>In view of the importance, public interest involved in the project, it is here by Recommended for diversion of 445.9565 ha of forest land in Package – IX (329.1385 ha) and package – X (116.818 ha) in Rajanna Siricilla district as per the proposals submitted by the User agency with following specific recommendations.</p>

		<p>1) The user agency shall take up soil moisture conservation works and catchment area treatment plan for the overall protection and improvement of the forest land in and around the diverted forest land area at the tentative unit rate of Rs.5000.00 per ha and to bear the cost of such proposals.</p> <p>2) The user agency shall supply water free of cost to the identified major locations to cater the needs of forest in and around the diverted forest areas.</p> <p>3) In package - IX, a gravity canal is proposed for a length of about 4.949 km which is separating an area of about 100ha in compt no. 176/2 from the Siricilla forest block as shown in the map, which affect the movement of wild life and there are chances of encroachments at later date, as it will become isolated patch. Hence, it is proposed for boundary protection of the area keeping in view of wild life movement and susceptibility for encroachment. Further, in compartment 179/3 in Siricilla (extrn.) Forest block, an area of about 200ha will get isolated due to submergence rest of forest area in the compartment and chain link fencing is proposed for protection of this area near Dharmaram village.</p>
