I have inspected the mining lease area for coal mining project applied by M/s. SCCL, Yellandu, falling in Compt., No. 34(P), 36 and 37 of Chatakonda Reserve Forest of Tekulapally Range on 02.12.2018 along with Forest Range Officer, Tekulapally and Range staff.

The area required for diversion of land as demarcated on the ground by DGPS survey by the User Agency comes to 694.159 Ha and break up area is as follows.

The proposed diversion of forest land over 694.159 Ha has got Misc., vegetation. The canopy density in the proposed area for diversion of forest land is below 0.4. The existing tree growth of Misc. species such as Pala (Manikara hexandra), Tuniki (Diospyros melanoxylon), Pharijatham (Nyctanthes arbor-tristis), Thogaru (Morinda tinctoria), Tiruman (Anogeissus latifolia), Pachari (Dalbergia paniculata), Billudu (Chloroxylon swietenia), Kodisa (Cleistanthus collinus), Bojja (Xylea xylocarpa), Bandaru (Adina cordifolia), Chilla (Strychnos potatorum), Gumpena (Lannea coromandelica), Chennangi (Lagestromia parviflora), Musti (Strychnos nuxvomica).

Since, the proposed diversion area is covered with large area of not possible for take up total enumeration permission was accorded from the Prl.C.C.F., T.S., Hyderabad to take up enumeration of sample plots as per density classes. The abstract of tree growth, density class wise is as follows. Since the entire tree growth Sample plot enumeration in 694.152 Ha cannot be enumerated. Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, T.S., Hyderabad has accorded permission to take up enumeration of sample plots as per density class.

The area of 694.159 Ha applied for mining lease is having undulated hillock to plain. Most of the plain area is under encroachment. As the total area will be used for mining, the vulnerability for erosion will not arise. The soil type is Red loamy soil with sandy patches. The proposed project area is located adjacent to the boundary line of the Eco-sensitive zone of Kinnerasani Wild Life Sanctuary.

Out of 694.159 Ha proposed for diversion approximately, about 542.35 Ha of forest land is under encroachment and cultivation of mainly cotton crop. Further, in this area RoFR certificates has also been issued.

Regarding Compensatory Afforestation land in lieu of Forest Land being diverted for Diversion of 694.159 Ha Forest land for Koyagudem OC-III in Chatakonda R.F., Tekulapally Range in favour of M/s. S.C.Co.Ltd., Yellandu and area of double the Degraded Forest Land i.e., 1388.31 Ha identified in Gangaram Range of Mahabubabad District. The District Forest Officer, Mahabubabad District will directly submit CA scheme to the CCF/CF, Kothagudem.

The proposed site does not have any monument or structure which is of archeological/cultural importance or any defense establishment. The company has not started any work in the proposed area and thus has not violated any provisions of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980. No VSS area falls in the proposed for diversion area.
