
**FIELD INSPECTION NOTE OF SRI J.GOPAL RAO F.S.F.,
FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, BANSWADA ON 21.02.2017 IN
GANDHARI RANGE, AREA PROPOSED FOR DIVERSION OF
FOREST LAND FOR WIDENING OF ROAD FORM CHEDMAL
TO GANDHARI MANDAL HEADQUATER**



On 21.02.2017 inspection the area proposed for diversion for widening of areas from Chedmal to Gandhari passing through compartment no. 767, Gandhari -I Block, Gandhari Beat, Section Gandhari of Gandhari Range. The proposed width of the road is 14 Mts and length of the road is 1.326 Km and commuted to 1.858 Ha. During inspection it is observed the species namely Ippa, Moduga, Vepa, Tellamaddi, Dirshanam, Thirman and Teak etc., are predominately existing in the area. Total number of trees are falling in proposed diverted area are 40 Nos.



Further the Telangana State Government is encouraging for laying of double road from all villages to Mandal headquarters for the better conveyance of local villagers. This road is more useful for the people staying in the interior village of Chedmal. It is found that there is no other alternate measure for diversion of land except this area.
