After field verification the actual Length of Forest diversion in Utnoor(FDPT) division is 6.95 Km. Thus, forming a BT road of 7.00 meters width will cause heavy loss of biodiversity. To minimize the impact of the road on biodiversity, the road width is reduced to 4.00Mt. Hence in view of protection of forest and requirement of up gradation of road, it is recommended the existing width of road for 4.00 Mtrs to be adopted for improving the BT road, instead of 7.00 Mtrs as proposed by the User agency and the diversion area in Utnoor Division reduced to 2.78 Ha. As per justification given by user agency and the field conditions, the barest minimum and unavoidable area for the project is 2.78 Ha.

13 Specific recommendation of the DCF for acceptance or other wise of the proposal with reasons

The project is intended to connect interior tribal village. The road connectivity improves the standard of life of the interior tribes and facilitates to transport agricultural produce to the nearest market centres.

Thus, the area i.e 2.78 Ha for diversion towards up gradation of road for BT road over a length of 6.95 Km with a width of 4.00 Mtrs, which is falling in Kawal Reserve forest in Utnoor(FDPT) Division is recommended considering all the aspects mentioned in the proposal and field conditions. Subject to approval of Wild life mitigation measures proposed and the following conditions are to be met.

1) The existing culverts and bridges on the roads must be converted into Animal passages. In addition to this, following are the places of animal passages.

2) The chain-link shall be placed on either side of the passages on both sides of road to a length of 100 Mt in a funnel model for diverting the wildlife towards animal passages.

3) Construction of checkpost with required infrastructure and provision of checkpost watchers for 03 years at the R&B- Allampally junction as proposed in WL mitigation

4) Speed Breakers shall be laid by the user agency at every 500 Mt for controlling the speed to prevent accidental deaths of wildlife.

5) UA shall place the signages at every 500 Mt on speed

6) UA should ensure protection of Forest and Wild life from fore.
