

Field inspection notes of Sri.P.Sagar, Forest Divisional Officer, Banswada; the area Proposal for diversion of Forest land and extent of 0.3751 Ha. In Banswada forest division of Kamareddy District. For laying of Optical fiber cable along the road and within the existing Right of way for execution of T - fiber Project in favour of M/s Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited of Banswada Range of Kamareddy District.

On 13.10.2021 I have inspected the Forest land proposed for diversion passing through Banswada Division for laying of Optical fiber cable along the road and within the existing Right of way in favour of **M/s Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited of Banswada Range of Kamareddy District.**

The proposed OFC is passing through the Reserve Forest area with a width of 0.45 M which is the area required for diversion in Banswada Range is 8334.63 Length at an extent area 0.3751 Ha is falls in Reserve Forest.

**Banswada Range:**



The proposed area is passing through i) Compartment No.272/2 Beat Nasrullabad, Hajipur RF, Nasrullabad Section of Banswada Range ii) Compartment No. 284 Beat Banswada, Tadkole-II RF, Banswada Section of Banswada Range. iii) Compartment No. 287 Beat Banswada, Thiumalapur-I RF, Banswada Section of Banswada Range. iv) Compartment No. 291 Beat & RF Maqdumpur, Banswada Section of Banswada Range. . v) Compartment No. 294, Beat Mohammadnagar, RF Thunkipally, Banswada Section of Banswada Range.

The diversion proposal map was verified on the ground and found that, the proposed area is passing through comp no. 272/2, 284, 287, 291, 294. till the day of inspection no work has been stated in violation of Forest Conservation Act, 1980.

**Other observations:**

1. In my field inspection there is no encroachment land is present in proposed diverted forest area.
2. The proposed area doesn't form part of National Park, wildlife sanctuary, biosphere reserve, tiger reserve, elephant corridor, etc.
3. No rare/ endangered/ unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.
4. No protected archaeological/ heritage site/ defence establishment of any other important monument is located in the area.
5. No work is carried out in violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980.
6. In this proposed diversion area there is no forest works carried out till today like Plantation, smc works, wildlife management works etc..
7. The requirement of Forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project which is 0.3751 Ha proposed by the User agency.

Hence it is recommended.
