Earlier the land was under revenue department and later handed over to forest department in 1999. The proposed road is an existing approach road mentioned in top sheet and it is being used by local villagers and the companies nearby. No adverse impact on ecology. There is an alternative road running from Koregaon Bhima to Talegaon Dhamdhere which is mentioned in village map. At present the part of the road is not in use because of encroachment. Hence no alternative road is available for the villagers except the existing road on forest area.
