The proposal has been initiated by Shri. Raju Kashiram Kadam under Forest (Conservation) Act-1980 for laying of pipeline from Sonal Project to private field for (Conservation) Act-1980 for laying of pipeline from Sonala Project to private field for irrigation purpose to private owned land in Gut No.25 at Sonala, Tal. Malegaon. The Sonala Dam was constructed on Adan River near Sonala village & completed in the year Sonala Dam was constructed on Adan River near Sonala village & completed in the year 1981 having catchment area 132.50 sqkm with storage capacity 20.27 mm<sup>3</sup> and irrigation Potential 3156 ha. (Sonala, Kherda, Hirangi, Lathi, Yedsi, Selu, Nagi, Wanoja, Tapowan, Potential 3156 ha. (Sonala, Kherda, Hirangi, Lathi, Yedsi, Selu, Nagi, Wanoja, Tapowan, Parhala, Masola, Pedgaon, Ganeshpur, Tal, Mangrulpit Disc, Washim). The total length of main canal is 15.25 km and the total length of Dam is 1114 mtrs proposed pipeline passing through forest land.

- 3.00 The user agency has been granted permission by the Executive Engineer, Minor Irrigation Division, Washim vide letter No. 1525, dt.27/03/2019 to take water for lift irrigation from Sonal Project. This pipeline project is demarcated on Survey of India Top sheet No. 55/H/8 and the forest area lies within Latitude and Longitude is N-20<sup>6</sup>18.640 to E-77<sup>6</sup>12.699 and N-20<sup>6</sup>18.739 to E-77<sup>6</sup>12.594. The site inspection report of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Akola Forest Division, Akola is enclosed on page no.24 to 25.
- 4.00 Following documents as prescribed in Government Circular, Revenue and Forest Department No.FLD-1081/2041/(A)/F-3, dated 20/03/1982 and according to Government of India's instructions issued from time to time are enclosed in three copies.
- 1) Prescribed form dated 10/01/2003.
- 2) Certificate regarding minimum demand of forest land for the project,
- 3) Area Statement,
- 4) Index map in suitable scale,

#### 5.00 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Akola Division, Akola has certified that:-

- 5.1 the area belongs to Eco-value class-III and having density less than 0.1 of Southern Tropical Dry Deciduous.
- 5.2 no alternate alignment is possible and the forest land required is the barest minimum.
- 5.3 there are no cutting and felling of trees involved in this project.
- 5.4 the proposed project boundary is beyond 10 kms from the boundary of Protected Area (Sanctuary and National Park).
- 5.5 the proposed area does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, and Nature Reserve etc.
- 5.6 proposed project is not likely to affect monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance.
- 5.7 there is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980
- 5.7 non forest area covered under the project is not under the provision of Maharashtra Private Forest (Acquisition) Act 1975 by virtue of application of Section 35 of Indian Forest Act 1927 and are not recognized as deemed reserved forest as well as not included in the area indentified as "forest" as per dictionary meaning of forest as intimated to the expert committee appointed under interim judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996.

### 6.00 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking that:-

- 6.1 the user agency has agreed to defray the cost of compensatory afforestation.
- 6.2 the user agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed under diversion.
- 7.0 The Collector, Washim has issued certificate-

- 7.1 that all other alternative for the purpose have been explored and the demand for the required is the barest minimum.
- value 7.2 under Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dweller's (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 issued vide their letters Desk Desk-4/WS-1175/2018,dt.24/10/2018 prescribed format Form- I as per Government of India guidelines dated 5/7/2013.
- 8.00 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Akola Forest Division, Akola and the Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Yavatmal Circle have recommended the proposal for diversion of 0.02 ha. of reserved forest land.
- 9.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under section 2 (ii) subject the following conditions-
  - 9.1 The legal status of the land required will remain unchanged.
  - 9.2 The agency will deposit the cost of raising plantation over 1.00 ha. (100 seedlings) of degraded forests land, in charge of the Forest Department.
  - 9.3 The pipe line will be laid in the strip of land having width 1.00 meter and depth up to 1.00 meter all along the length through the forest.
  - 9.4 The user agency will defray the cost of Net Present Value of 0.02 ha. of forest land as per the latest Guideline of Government of India.
  - 9.5 The User Agency will defray the additional / revised cost of Net Present Value of Forest land as per the latest Guideline of Government of India.
  - 9.6 The User Agency has agreed to defray the cost of compensatory afforestation over 1.00 hadegraded forest land.
  - 9.7 The User Agency will furnish a certificate to make good any loss to forest /environment while laying the underground pipeline in the forest area and during maintenance of the same in future.
  - 9.8 It will be responsibility of the User Agency to ensure that the labourers or staff engaged in pipeline activity do not cause any damage to the nearby forest flora and fauna.
  - 9.9 In case of non-compliance of any of the above conditions, the concerned Divisional Forest Officer shall report through the State Government to this office as per procedure laid sown in the clause 1.9 of guidelines issued under Forest (Conservation) Act-1980 on 25/10/1992.
  - 9.10 No new forest area beyond the limited width of existing road shall be broken for laying of underground pipeline.
  - 10.0 The project agency shall restore the land to its level by proper back filling after excavation & pipe laying work is completed.
  - 10.1 The User Agency shall ensure that no damage is caused on adjoining area.
  - 10.2 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the proposal;
  - 10.3 All other conditions as may be mandatory under relevant Acts, Rules and guidelines shall be complied with by the user agency.

It is therefore, requested that Government of India may kindly be moved for 11.00 approving the proposal for Proposal for diversion of 0.02 ha.
