**Proposal No. –FP/JH/SCH/36884/2018**


An area of 1.99 ha. of GMJJ (deemed forest) land is required to be diverted for this proposal.

The proposed site was inspected on 01.07.2019 along with sri Ved Prakash Kamboj, IFS, DFO, Latehar Forest Division, Range Officer of Forest, Balumath & other local field staff of Balumath Range and representatives of the User Agency.

The average density of vegetation is 0.3 .

A total of 44 trees have been enumerated in the proposal area. Although all the enumerated trees shall not be required to be felled. Species of trees in the area are Sal and Mahua. The User Agency should remove only minimum number of trees in this project.

Important wildlife species found in the near by forest areas are wild cat, Jackal, Fox, Hare, Common langur, Cobra, Krait, Python, Porcupine, Pangolin etc.
