Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons

The diversion of forest land is proposed for providing and laying of under ground pipeline for providing safe drinking water in Manthani and Bhupalpally Assembly Constituencies. The proposed area for diversion is linear i.e. for laying of under ground pipe line The area proposed for diversion is mostly passing along the road side in R.F. as per field verification the area comes to **9.305 Ha.** The work of laying pipeline is underground and linear for creation of critical public utility infrastructure for providing the safe drinking water in the Left Wing extremism affected district.

Hence it is recommended for diversion of 9.305 Ha. of forest land in Compt. Nos. and Beats as listed at Sl. No. 7 (v) above for laying of under ground pipeline for providing safe drinking water with the fallowing conditions.

1. Construction of supervisory hut is to be taken up to ensure the protection of forests for an amount of Rs 15.00 Lakhs.

2.Engaging of protection watchers for 5nos for a period of 5 years for better protection of forests.

3.Errection of publicity cum awareness boards 30 nos to be done to sensitize the public. The detailed estimates are attached. The execution of the work will be done by forest department by raising of demand notice for the total amount.
