- 1. It is observed that the proposed area is for project is falling in Compt. No.s 808, 803 of Govindapur Beat of Pakhal Block, Compt. No. 662 of Pakhal-II Beat, Compt. No.s 675, 676 of Pakhal-I Beat, Compt. No.s 681, 682 of Khanapur Beat of Khanapur Block & Compt. No. 690/1, 1044/1 of Bhudaraopet Beat of Ponugodu Block.
- 2. It is observed that the proposal is falling in Pakhal Wildlife Sanctuary area.
- 3. It is observed that there is no three growth in RF area which is adjacent to road where T-Fiber will be laid within the boundary line of the road, but adjacent forest has density of 0 to 0.1.
- 4. Further User Agency informed that they will alignment in such a way that no tree is fell.
- 5. Diversion of Forest land to the T-Fiber Project area of 0.4768 Ha. Proposed in Warangal District for diversion is the barest minimum for laying of pipe line over an extant of 0.4768 Ha. - It is observed that no endangered wild animals are present in this location by water source to wild life should be developed.
- It is observed that in the proposed site, there are no protected archeological/ heritage site/ defense establishment or any other important monuments.
