FIELD INSPECTION REPORT OF THE DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER, GUNTUR ON 17.04.2019 IN CONNECTION WITH THE DIVERSION OF FOREST LAND OVER AND EXTENT OF 4.49 Ha. OF FOREST LAND FOR EXTRACTION OF ROAD METAL AND GRAVEL IN FAVOUR OF SRI DARA APPA RAO, R/o. YADAVOLU (V), DEVARAPALLI (M), WEST GODAVARI DISTRICT.

A proposal has been received from the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), A.P., Guntur vide Rc.No: EFS02-15029/33/2018-FCA-SEC PCCF/FCA-2 Dated: 17-02-2019 applied for by Sri Dara Appa Rao, R/o. Yadavolu (V), Devarapalli (M), W.G. District for diversion of 4.49 ha of forest land in Compt No. 127 of Kondaveedu Extension I Reserve Forest, Ameenabad Beat, Guntur Range, Guntur Division and District under Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 for extraction of Road metal and Building Stone in favour of Sri Dara Appa Rao, R/o. Yadavolu (V), Devarapalli (M), W.G. District. The subject envisages the use of forest land for 4.49 Ha. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal was done by the Divisional Forest Officer, Guntur on 17.04.2019 together with the Forest Range Officer, Guntur and concerned section staff.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the User Agency is a forest area measuring 4.49 Ha.

The area is plain having gentle slope. There is no vulnerability to soil erosion.

It is classified as ECO – Class IV consisting of Tropical Thorn Forest and Tropical Dry ever green forests of open type.

The area is devoid of vegetation. The density of vegetation stands is 0.10 to 0.20
