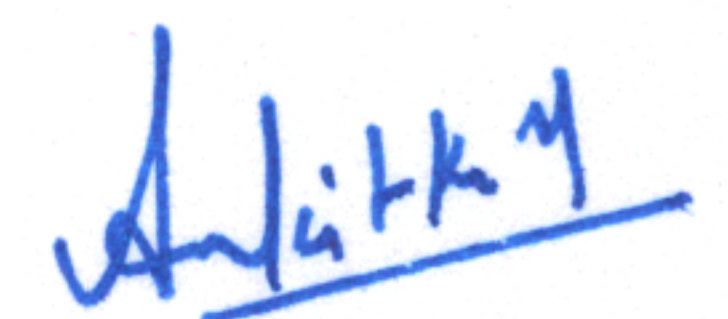

The crop density of deemed forest and notified forest area for this linear diversion proposal is approx 0.4. There are standing trees of Acacia, Banyan, Chillar, Chirchiri, Doka, Dumar, Gamhar, Jamun, Kadam, Karanj, Mahogany, Mahua, Mango, Neem, Palash, Parmi, Peepal, Sal, Salai, Shisham, Siris etc. No endangered species were observed though occasional elephant presence is noted in nearby villages. Common wildlife including Jackals, Hares & Snakes etc. The area has sparse vegetation & patches of exposed soil, contributed to a heightened risk of erosion, particularly in the

moderately undulating terrain. No protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monuments is located in proposed diversion areas.

The proposed site was inspected physically and there are no feasible alternatives possible for laying of transmission line.
