



The proposed site was inspected on..... The factual details regarding the Proposed site and consequent findings are stated below:-

1. The Proposed site is lies in the side of the SH-56 Mauza-Uchati, Thana-Biraul, Thana No- 298 District- Darbhanga. Khata no- 183 (old) 1020 (new) khesra no- 2899 (old) 3777, 3778 (new) . The Proposed area is a part of protected Forest vides Government of Bihar Notification No-189E/190E dated 16-02-1994. The forest land required in order to establish outlet is 0.0195 Ha. as per map attached with this Proposal.
2. There was total no of tree found to be 8 total trees would be translocated. There are no rare/endangered/unique species of flora & fauna found in the area. No archaeological site is present near the proposed outlet.
3. The user agency has not done any work on the site.
