Specific recommendations of the DCF of acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons.		<p>Few are the specific recommendations with regard to the present road proposal :-</p> <p>(1) Some portion of the proposed forest area and its surrounding area is vulnerable to erosion. So, a scheme containing soil and moisture conservation activities should be proposed for the aforesaid area.</p> <p>(2) Also, the adjoining areas has been visited by elephant herds. So, a special elephant management plan should be proposed for the whole stretch.</p> <p>(3) The stretch is vast and is surrounded by dense forested areas, therefore a Scorpio vehicle should be provided by the user agency to this division for regular monitoring of different schemes.</p> <p>In addition to above, owing to its critical importance in infrastructure & associated development, the proposed road is recommended for acceptance.</p>
