

Inspection note, finding and recommendations with reasons.

The proposed site was inspected on 19-05-2018. The Deputy Conservator of Forest and subordinate staffs, were Present and helped during the inspection. The factul details regarding the Proposed site and consequent findings are stated below:-


- 1- The Proposed site is situated on SH- 88 Darbhanga- Behari-Singhiya- Kusheswar Sthan road. The land for establishment of retail outlet is Khata no-152 Kheshra no-396 District- Samastipur. The road is a protected Forest vide Government of Bihar Notification No- 189E/190E dated 16-02-1994.
- 2- The user agency proposed for diversion of 0.013875 Ha of forest land in order to use for entry & exit of the vehicles from retail outlet.
- 3- There are no trees present on the site. No rare/endangered/unique species of flora & fauna found in the area. No archaeological site is present in and around the proposed outlet.
- 4- The user agency has not done any work on the site. The width of entry & exit each would be 7.5 m, including the flank.

On the basis of the recommendation of the Deputy Conservator of Forests and the inspection made by me, the proposal may be accepted due to following reasons :-

- 1- The denisity of the road side Protected Forest is very low. The acceptance of the proposal, as it entails, provision of compensatory afforestation along the road side, as is costumary, may help to increase forest density & green cover.
- 2- The forest area involved in this Proposal is only 0.013875 Ha, which is bare minimum & is quite negligible.
