SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

(For the Forest land to be diverted under FCA-1980)

The proposed site requiring forest clearance of protected forest land to be diverted for Laying of Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) along with road on Sisaiya-Dhaurhara-Nighasan-Paliya-Dhanauraghat-Puranpur Marg (NH-101) from KM 83.00 To KM 109.40 (On L.H.S.) total 26.40 km & 0.276 ha area in North Kheri Forest Division Lakhimpur Kheri, was inspected by the undersigned on 19.12.2020 along with Sri O.P. Singh, range forest officer, Palia Range and Sri Bijendra Singh, Dy. Ranger Palia.

The area proposed for diversion of protected forest is 0.276 ha.

Rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area. The protected forest is not part of notified buffer zone of Dudhwa Tiger Reserve, where the proposed site is situated. Notified buffer includes only reserve forest of Tiger Reserve where tiger, the flagship species is found and movement of tigers along with other wild animals is rare in the proposed area as proposed site connects two towns ie. Palia and Sampurna nagar.

In the proposed project there is no protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument located in the area.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project. So there is no need of alternatives to be examined.

The user agency has not carried out any work in violation of the Act.

Recommendation. Since the requirement of Protected Forest land for Laying of Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) along with the road is minimum, no tree is to cut and no alternative is available hence the project is recommended for the benefit/interest of local people.
