reasons.

- The Laknavaram Tourist place is the major attraction in Mulugu district and the tourist visit during the weekends and public holidays which inconvenience to the tourist by jamming the traffic and it is not possible by the forest department and TSTDC to manage the traffic flow which sometimes leads to small accidents. To avoid this it is very much essential to the construct the bund cum parallel road for free flow of traffic for the tourists and also the Construction of reception centre with the basic amenities like Hospitality, Cloak Room etc., for the tourist with approach road from parking area. The project is recommended to the following conditions including.
  - 1. They should not disturb / damage flora and fauna during the execution of the project. They should try to avoid tree damage during execution of growth.
  - 2. The user agency should follow F(C)Act, 1980 strictly.
  - 3. Local tribe should be given preference for creation of employment.
  - 4. The user agency shall carry out the works only during 6.00 AM to 6.00 PM.
  - 5. The UA shall take approval from Irrigation department for construction of bund.
  - 6. Erection of publicity sign boards (5) no's with the size of (8'x12') should be taken up across the Division at designated place demarcated by Forest Department for an amount of Rs. 5.00 Lakhs @ Rs. 1.00 Lakhs each.
  - 7. Construction of (1) No watch tower is proposed @ Rs. 10.00 Lakhs.
