The above points are verified on field and found tallied.

The density of adjacent RF is 0.50. The area falls in Eco-Class IV (Tropical thorn forests) Dense forest.

The area proposed does not fall in any Sanctuary. The species such as *Acacia leucophloea*, *azardirachta indica*, *Albizzia amara* etc. are noticed in the proposed area.

The user agency has not violated the provisions of FC Act, 1980 and Wild life (Protection) Act, 1972 in the said Forest area. There are no rare/endangered species of fauna that are reported. The proposed RF areas are not vulnerable for erosion.
