The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Thane has submitted the proposal mentioned in the subject vide his letter No. D-25/Survey/FCA/181, dated 27.04.2022, Xerox copy of the same is enclosed herewith for your ready reference. The project has been initiated by Project Director, NHAI, PIU, Thane, MTNL Building, Opp. to Babubhai Petrol Pump, Near Castle Mill Circle, LBS Road, Thane (West).

2.00 The Project Proponent highlighted that "National Highway Development Project (NHDP) Phase-VI is for development of 1000 km of expressways and includes construction of about 379 km long Vadodara-Mumbai Expressway (VME) including SPUR. Expressway proposed to be implemented under Public Private Partnership mode and to be executed as Design, Build, Finance and Operate (DBFO) contracts.

The proposed project is the development of 8 lane SPUR of Vadodara Mumbai Expressway (VME) starting from km 26.582 of VME main alignment and terminating at proposed junction with the Multi-Modal Corridor of MMRDA in the state of Maharashtra. It is a green field alignment and length of the SPUR alignment to be developed in the initial stage is 79.783 km."
