


SITE INSPECTION REPORT

The Undersigned had carried out the Site inspection of the proposed Widening/Improvement of Kaying-Tato Road from Km 11.350 to Km 19.950 and Km 28.600 to Km 86.600 (Total length- 66.600 Km) from existing road to NHDL Specifications under project Brahmark by the Commander HQ 44 BRTF C/O 99 APO in the area falling under Along Forest Division on 17/12/2022. The specific observations regarding diversion of 39.093 Ha of forest land for implementation of the project as per Part-II clause-II of the proposal are as under :-

1. About 39.093 Ha of forest area will be required for execution of the road project. These area are USF area.
2. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the commander HQ 44 BRTF C/O 99 APO has been found to be unavoidable and the barest minimum.
3. Protected Archaeological/Heritage sites/ Defence establishment are not noted at the proposed project area.
4. The user agency has applied for diversion of forest land as per procedure. Violation of the provision of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 has not been noted during the time of inspection.
5. No illegal timber operation, hunting/poaching of wildlife was noted during the time of field inspection.
