

The proposed area for diversion is linear i.e. for laying of under ground pipe line The area proposed for diversion is mostly passing along the road side in R.F. as per field verification the area comes to <b>3.807 Ha.</b> The work of laying pipeline is underground and linear for creation of critical public utility infrastructure for providing the safe drinking water in the Left Wing extremism affected district. Hence <b>it is recommended for diversion of 3.807 Ha.</b> of forest land in Compt. Nos. and Beats as listed at Sl. No. 7 (v) above for laying of under ground pipeline for providing safe drinking water Subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions a degraded area will be taken for taking up to rejuvenation of the forest &amp; improving this area for which the following activities are proposed.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Construction of a supervisory hut is to be take-up to ensure the protection of forests for an amount Rs 15.00Lackhs</li> <li>2) Engaging of protection watchers for 5 Nos for a period of 5 years for better protection of forests</li> <li>3) Erection of publicity cum awareness boards 30 Nos to be done to sensitize the public</li> </ol> <p>The detailed estimates are attached.
