
The proposal pertains to diversion of 31.588 Ha of Forest Land for Construction of 400 KV DC Bongaigaon - Nangalbibra Line by Nangalbibra - Bongaigaon Transmission Limited which passes through 18 (Eighteen) different patches of Deemed Forest Land. As per the observations of the concerned DFO elephant movement were recorded in some parts of the proposed diversion, hence relevant rules and guidelines of MoEFCC must be adhered by the user agency.

This proposed transmission line will improve the power supply to the East Garo Hills and South Garo Hills Districts which in turn will promote other Social and Economic activities of the district, considering the greater benefit for the region.
