Since the said land comes under the jurisdiction of Marine National Park & Sanctuary, this office ordered M/s Hind Marine Works to stop their activity and based on that M/s Hind Marine Works voluntarily stoped their activity. Lateron M/s Hind Marine Works claim a case in the Gujarat High Court by SCA No. 726/2013 and on 10/07/2013 Gujarat High Court orally ordered agency to submitt fresh application/proposal. So currently, the demanded said land is under the charge of Marine National Park, Jamnagar where there is no violation.

Rest of the area is full of mud skippers which is an important bio-indicator.
