13	Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposals with reasons	The project aims to provide every household, government institution and private enterprise across the rural part of the state through optical fiber and provide them with High-speed internet connectivity. Government of Telangana has envisioned to establish a state-of-the-art network infrastructure to serve as backbone for Digital Telangana. It passes through Reserve Forest, Nagarjuna sagar (WLM) division and is a part of Amrabad Tiger Reserve. The Forest area requested for diversion is 1.3105 ha which is unavoidable and barest minimum. The User Agency has not committed any violation of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980. The laying of cables is under the ground and no disturbance to the wildlife and its habitat. Hence the proposals is RECOMMENDED .
