10	<p>Background note on the proposal (Short summary)</p>	<p>The proposal for construction of existing Narayangaon-Ozar-Otur road widening at village-Dhalewadi Tarf Haveli Tal-Junnar, Dist-Pune. The Government of Maharashtra decided to connect all Ashtavinayak Ganapati Devasthan road in the premises of Pune District. This Narayangaon-Ozar-Otur road is the one part of this plan and sanctioned 89 Crore Amt. for widening and strengthening this road.</p> <p>The existing Narayangaon-Ozar-Otur road is passing through Reserved Forest land Forest Comptt. no. 45, Gat no. 136 (Old Survey no. 146) and Gat no. 147 (Old Survey no.35) village-Dhalewadi Tarf Haveli, Tal-Junnar, Dist-Pune. But in this road at the site of Dhalewadi Tarf Haveli, Tal-Junnar there is an accidental spot. While passing through the road at chainage no. 61/250 to 61/675 the spot in Forest area is a hill track, blind corner and the front side cannot be sighted, which creates an accident prone zone.</p> <p>Due to the above circumstances it is very necessary to widen this road which is to be passing through the Reserved forest area of Forest Comptt. no. 45, Gat no. 136 (Old Survey</p>

		<p>no. 146) and Gat no. 147 (Old Survey no.35) village-Dhalewadi Tarf Haveli, Tal-Junnar, Dist-Pune.</p> <p>The road is existing before 1980 which is shown in the Survey of India Topo-sheet no.47 E-16, hence there is no option to examine other alternative. For widening of road 0.34 hector forest land is required.</p> <p>The forest area is to be diverted is not sensitive for any flora and fauna. The proposed work in forest is will not have any adverse effect on the ecology of the area and no trees required to be felled. Hence the proposal is recommended for sanction.</p>
