The major species found in the proposed project area are Shorea robusta, Lagerstroemia parviflora, Albezzia labbeck, Dalbergia latifolia, Lagerstroemia parviflora, Terminalia tomentosa, Semecarpus anacardium, Buchanania lanzan, Anogeissus latifolia, Pterocarpus marsupium, Anogeissus latifolia, Syzigium cumini, Anacardium occidentale, Diospyros melanoxylon, Madhuca indica, Xylia xylocarpa.
