



**OFFICE OF THE DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER,
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**Specific Recommendation for proposal of
Konar Washery-68.40ha.**

- * The proposed site is located within the mining cluster, the entire region is highly vulnerable to soil erosion. So, it is very important that a soil erosion conservation plans are made and implemented in the adjoining protected forests of the entire mining cluster especially in the PFs of Dugda, Chandrapura, Chirudih, Tarmi, Pichhari, Chapri, Mungo, Nasia, Goladih, Chhotki-Kurim Pilpilo, Kurpania & Chalkari, the plan to be prepared by the forest department and the funds should be made available by CCL.
- * As the area has a high number of trees i.e. 18,137, and is a sal forest the option of transplanting the trees by tree trans-planter should be looked into, since the sal forest lost is lost forever, the active root stocks along with the trees should be transplanted in the adjacent degraded forest land.
- * Since in the entire area, cluster mining is being done and the impact on biodiversity is immense. So it is highly recommended to develop a biodiversity park to maintain the germ plasm along with hi-tech nurseries in the area and bother exists and insitu conservation.
- * The Damodar river is highly vulnerable to pollution, hence a green belt plantation should be taken up in the adjoining forest areas on the either side of river banks adjoining mining areas.

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
