

## FIELD INSPECTION NOTE OF THE FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, Nizamabad ON 22.10.2019 IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED DIVERSION OF RESERVE FOREST LAND FOR LAYING OF CC ROAD FROM MOSRA R & B ROAD TO SRI VIGNESWARA DATTA SAI MANDIRAM VIA SRI LAXMI VENKATESHWARA SWAMI DEVALAYAM


As per the request made by Engineer-in Chief, Panchayat Raj, Hyderabad, I have inspected the site for Laying of CC road from Mosra R & B road to Sri Vigneshwara Datta Sai Mandiram via Sri Laxmi Venkateshwara Swami Devalayam in Mosra Forest Block of Compt. Nos. 215 of Mosra Beat Mosra Section of Varni Range of Nizamabad Forest Division of Nizamabad District along with concerned Panchayat Raj and Forest Officials. The User Agency has requested for diversion of 0.231 Ha of Forest land for Laying of CC road from Mosra R & B road to Sri Vigneshwara Datta Sai Mandiram via Sri Laxmi Venkateshwara Swami Devalayam.

The proposed alignment is a linear patch passing through the Reserve Forest (Mosra RF) and the extent is 0.231 Ha. The User Agency, Executive, Engineer, PR, Sub-Division Bodhan-I has got the area demarcated on the ground.

I have attended the field inspection along with District Forest Officer, Nizamabad and with the Forest Range Officers, Varni and concerned staff on 22.10.2019 and concerned Panchayat Raj Staff and Mosra Village development committee and it was observed that 73 Nos Trees are existing in the proposed alignment for laying CC road from Mosra R & B road to Sri Vigneshwara Datta Sai Mandiram via Sri Laxmi Venkateshwara Swami Devalayam.

The total forest area involved is to an extent of 0.231 Ha in Nizamabad Forest Division which is as follows:

The wildlife present in the surrounding forest areas as informed by the local staff are Bear, Neelgai, Pea fowl, Spotted Deer, Wild pig etc. However no wild life was spotted at the time of field inspection.

I have searched for alternatives, but there is no other alternative alignment available except the present proposal. This is the barest minimum area that is required for laying of road from Mosra R & B road to Sri Vigneshwara Datta Sai Mandiram via Sri Laxmi Venkateshwara Swami Devalayam

The User Agency has submitted undertakings to implement the following conditions:

- The Net Present Value (NPV) of Rs.1.855 lakhs shall be paid by the User Agency.
- Extraction and Construction of Boundary Pillars of Rs.3.079 lakhs shall be paid by the User Agency.

The area does not fall in wildlife protected areas and there is no archaeological heritage site, important monuments in the proposed alignment.

The District Collector, Nizamabad has given the certificate in Form-I as per instructions vide GOI, MoEF Ref.11-9/98-Fc (PT) dt:05.07.2013 for linear projects, duly certifying that the process of identification of Rights under Forest Rights Act has been completed in the District and there are no claims pending in the above said Reserve Forest areas.

Hence, the proposals for laying of CC road from Mosra R & B road to Sri Vigneshwara Datta Sai Mandiram via Sri Laxmi Venkateshwara Swami Devalayam in 0.231 Ha of Compt.Nos.215 (Mosra RF) Mosra Beat Mosra Section of Varni Range of Nizamabad Forest Division of Nizamabad District are recommended with the following conditions.

- The Legal status of the Reserve Forest land proposed to be diverted does not change.
- User Agency has to put two permanent boards at the entrance and exit points of the RF in the above locations about the status of the land and also construct boundary pillars separating the proposed area for diversion at every 20 mts interval.
- 3. Any other conditions imposed by Forest Divisional Officer, Nizamabad from time to time shall be followed by the User Agency.

The Proposals for diversion of 0.231 Ha of Reserve Forest land for laying CC road from Mosra R & B road to Sri Vigneshwara Datta Sai Mandiram via Sri Laxmi Venkateshwara Swami Devalayam are **recommended**.
