SITE INSPECTION REPORT

(For the Forest Land to be diverted under FCA)

A Proposal has been received by this office from Project Manager, Construction Unit U.P. Jal Nigam, Jhansi for laying of Drinking Water Pipeline under Jhansi Reorganisation water supply scheme phase-1 for diversion under (FCA-1980) of 0.4 hac. of Protected/Reserved Forest land for non-forestry Purpose. The Project envisages the use of forest land for Laying Jhansi-Bhagwantpura Baya Mauranipur National Highway No- 39 from k.m. 1.00 to 04.00 (Left side ROW) Tehsil-Jhansi, District Jhansi The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by DFO on dated **11.09.2020**

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Protected forest measuring 0.4 hac.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col.2 part- 1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
