I have inspected the site of proposed P.R. road from Chalamala to Uyyalamadugu in Charla Range on 30.08.2019. The proposed road passing through in Compt.No.72 of Pedamidisileru R.F. Block. The details are as furnished below.

The User Agency proposed for 2.233 Ha. for the diversion of the forest land for the construction and upgradation of road. The part of the road is formed with metal and the rest of the area is Cart Track along the R.F. boundary line of Pedamdisileru R.F. Uyyalamadugu Beat, compt.No.72. The construction of boundary pillars are noticed along the R.F. boundary line.

The User Agency has to furnish RoFR certificate in Form-I along with Gramasabha Resolutions.

Proposed road is falling in the Southern Tropical Dry Deciduous Forests (5A) as per Champion and Seth classification. The proposed forest land for diversion for the proposed project is barest minimum and unavoidable. The type of soil is Red soil. The average density of the forest is 0.40 with plain lands and non-vulnerable to erosion. There are no any rare or endangered or unique species of flora and fauna found in this area and any protected archaeological or heritage site or defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area. The proposed project is a public important project providing basic amenities in the remotest tribal villages in left wing extremism affected areas.
