**SITE INSPECTION REPORT**


The proposed site for diversion of 0.913 hectares of forest land in Sy No.25 of Thindlu village and Sy No.7 of Tarabahalli village of Jadigenahalli Hobli, Thindlu Plantation, Hosakote Range, Hosakote Taluk, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka state for Special road repairs and Improvement to road from IOCL connecting to HP gas and reaching to ITC Foods Ltd from IOCL junction to upto Sy No.19/1 Thindlu Village in favour of Executive Engineer, Public Works Ports & Inland Water Transport Department (PWP & WTD) Bangalore Division was inspected personally by me on 27.August.2021, 03.September.2021 and 01.October.2021.

Executive Engineer, Public Works Ports & Inland Water Transport Department (PWP & WTD) Bangalore Division has submitted online application for diversion of 0.913 hectares vide online proposal No. FP/KA/ROAD/141816/2021 [FORM-A] under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

The proposed unit of land measuring 0.913 ha falls in Thindlu Plantation Reserve Forest. The Type of Forest is of Eco class-III with Tropical Dry Deciduous Open Forest. It was found during the inspection that there is tar road of width 3.5 meters existing in the proposed area, which was done very long back. Moreover, there are no trees that are required to be felled in the area to be diverted. There are no rare/endangered/ unique species of flora and fauna found in the proposed area.

The proposed forest land is not part of any National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger reserve, Elephant Corridor, etc. There is no area of protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument involved.
