On 04/07/2019 proceeded and inspected the area proposed for diversion of 0.2555 Ha of Forest-Land in Compt. No. 397, 398, 400 & 408 of Kotakonda Forest Block area of Narayanpet & Dhanwada Section of Narayanpet Range and on 04/07/2019 0.0859 Ha of Forest land in Compt. No. 156 of Pursampally Forest Block of Mohammadabad Range, Mahabubnagar Forest Division for laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road and within the existing Right of way in favour of M/s. Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd., is transacted and observed that:

The total Forest Area in Compt. No. 397, 398, 400 & 408 of Kotakonda Reserve Forest is 1110.54 Ha, Compt. No. 156 of Pursampally Reserve Forest is 154.590 Ha. The Forest Area of this Compartments Area is degraded area and having only bushy and miscellaneous growth. The canopy density is about 0.20. There are no Trees falling in the proposed area for laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road and within the existing Right of way, in the proposed areas of Kotakonda & Pursampally Reserve Forests. There are no rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna in this proposed area and also there are no protected archaeological / heritage site/defence establishment.

The degraded Forest area diverted for this purpose is only <u>0.3414 Ha.</u> The area proposed for laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road Passing through the Naryanpet, Dhanwada sections of Kotakonda Reserve Forest Block in Narayanpet Range & Marikal Section of Pursampally Reserve Forest Block in Mohammadabad Range of Mahabubnagar District, in favour of M/s. Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd., also provides internet connectivity from Villages to Mandals, and Mandals to District Head Quarters.

There are no rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna in this proposed area and also there are no protected archaeological / heritage site/defence establishment. Etc.,

Hence, it is recommended to divert the Forest Area.
