


Recommendation of the Proposal no.- FP/JH/FVC/46701/2020

Palamau Tiger Reserve is one of the first nine tiger reserves of our country. It has been home of many tigers. As the population of tigers started decreasing countrywide, it also lost its tigers and numbers diminished severely. The presence of human population inside core area had been main reason for decline of tiger population in almost all tiger reserves of country and it was dealt with utmost priority by relocating more than 600 villages from tiger reserves. Under the aegis of Project Tiger, several other tiger reserves bounced back to a thriving population of big cats, however, Jharkhand's only tiger reserve, Palamau Tiger Reserve could not achieve same feat. One of the major reasons can be attributed to failure in creating large inviolate space for breeding of tigresses by relocating villages from core area of tiger reserve.


Palamau Tiger Reserve has eight villages inside core area. Three villages viz. Latu, Kujrum and Henar are settled in the heart of the reserve. So these three villages must be relocated outside for conservation of tiger and other wild animals.

This proposal has been submitted for relocation of Kujrum, Latu and other villages situated inside Palamau Tiger Reserve. As relocation is a voluntary exercise, the area applied for forest land diversion has been selected by villagers themselves. The area applied for diversion is outside tiger reserve. It is an open and degraded forest. It is situated very near to Daltonganj town. There is also a State Highway along Polpol PF. It will provide villagers an opportunity to lead a much better life in comparison to the present location which is located much inside the forest without connectivity of pucca road. It will also make available an inviolate area for conservation of wild animals and for the breeding of tigresses in Palamau Tiger Reserve.

Hence, the proposal is recommended.
