It is submitted that, in the reference 1st cited, the DGM-Regulatory-RoW, M/s Jio Digital Fibre Private Limited, Vijayawada has initiated a proposal in the PARIVESH portal for diversion of 0.36 ha of forest land falling in Compartment nos.322 & 323, Gopavaram RF, Rampurma Beat and Compartment no.332, Gopavaram Extn.RF, Valleruvaripalli Beat and Compartment no.291, C.Kothapalli RF, Valleruvaripalli Beat of Badvel Range, Proddatur WL Division (presently in Kadapa Division) for laying optical fibre cable along within the admitted Right of Way between Badvel and Padamatinaidupalli village for providing 4G communication in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

On 16.03.2022, the proposal was forwarded to the erstwhile DFO, Proddatur WL division for processing the proposal as per the Forest Conservation Rules, 2003 and guidelines issued by Government of India from time to time under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

In the reference cited, the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kurnool Circle, Kurnool has submitted the proposal duly processed under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The details of the proposal are as follows.

The User Agency has furnished the following information in Part-I:

 For locating this project on forest land, the User Agency has justified that the Optical Fiber Cable is generally laid along the admitted RoW

of State / National Highway roads and such road side area is declared as the Protected Forest under the Indian Forest Act. The area requested for laying of the Optical Fiber Cable is the bare minimum considering the requirements and also considering the safety of the cables so laid. Since, the telecommunication cables also carry the communication from the Government offices, Defense Strategic establishments and from different industrial organizations apart from the general public, for the safety and confidentiality of the conversation so made it is not advisable to lay such important cables on the private land belonging to different parties. The cable alignment will be suitably diverted to avoid any cutting of trees and laid within the road land boundary by excavating a narrow trench of 50 cms. width (approx.). The same strip of trench will be reinstated to its original condition and also no structure will be erected on the cable route.

- Non-forest land required for the project is 0.86 ha.
- Temporary employment likely to be generated is 13520 number of person days.
- The User agency has submitted undertakings to bear the cost of raising and maintenance of compensatory afforestation in any of the degraded forest land, payment of NPV, additional NPV, tree Extraction charges and escalation charges, if any, as per the scheme prepared by the State Government and also undertaking to provide RoFR before during issuance of Stage-II approval.
- The user agency has uploaded the authenticated DGPS surveyed maps for the area proposed for diversion.

The District Forest Officer, Kadapa has furnished the following information in part-II:-

- Site was inspected on 19.07.2023.
- The District Forest Officer, Kadapa in Rc.no.221/2022/A14, dt.20.07.2023 has submitted that, after thorough inspection with reference to Gazette notification, RSR, FMB and Village map, only Bit-I area i.e., 0.12 ha out of 0.36 ha proposed for diversion, is falling in Compartment no.322 of Gopavaram RF, Ramapuramu Beat, Badvel Range and rest of area (Bit-2 0.19 ha and Bit-3 0.05 ha) is falling outside RF.
- .The forest land proposed is a notified RF.
- Density of vegetation is around 0.2 (Eco-Class-III Open Forest).
- 35 nos. of tree to be felled in the area required for diversion.
- Not vulnerable to erosion.
- Approximate distance of the proposed site for diversion from boundary of forest is 0 km.
- The area required for diversion does not form part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor, wildlife migration corridor etc.
- The area required for diversion is not located within the Eco-Sensitive Zone of P.A notified under W(P) Act, 1972 or within 10 km of ESZ of P.A to be notified.
- No National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor, wildlife migration corridor etc. is located within 1 km

from the boundary of forest land proposed for diversion.

- No rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.
- No protected archaeological/heritage site/defense establishments or any other important monuments are located in the area.
- The forest land proposed for diversion is the barest minimum for the project.
- No work in violation of Forest (Conservation) Act. 1980 has been carried out.

The District Forest Officer, Kadapa has recommended the proposal in Part-II for 0.12 ha. The Chief Conservator of Forests, Kurnool Circle, Kurnool has agreed with the information provided in PART-II by the DFO, Kadapa and recommended the proposal in Part-III.

The proposal recommending in PART IV is submitted herewith. The Government are requested to consider and process the proposal for issuance of in-principle/Stage-I approval under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

Adverting to the reference cited, it is submitted that in reference 2nd cited, the District Forest Officer, Kadapa has submitted the above subject proposals u/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.12 Ha. of forest land in Compt.No.322 of Gopavaram Reserve forest in Ramapuram Beat of Badvel Range of Kadapa Division for laying OFC along the existing RoW between Badvel and Padamatinaidupalli (V). It is further submitted by the District Forest Officer, that the user agency has uploaded the Part-I proposals in Parivesh portal vide proposal No.FP/AP/OFC/148408/2021, Dt.17.12.2021 for diversion of 0.36 Ha. in (3) Bits i.e., Bit-I-0.12 Ha., Bit-II-0.19 Ha. and Bit-III-0.05 Ha. Totalling 0.36 Ha.

During the site inspection of District Forest Officer on 19.07.2023, it is noticed by the District Forest Officer that Bit-I area of 0.12 Ha. is only falling in Compt.No.322 of Gopavaram Reserve forest and the rest of the area i.e., Bit-II area 0.19 Ha. and Bit-III – 0.05 Ha. for which DGPS survey carried out and authenticated by the GIS cell, Office of the Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests, Andhra Pradesh, Guntur is falls outside Reserve forest as verified with reference to Gazette notification of the concerned Block, RSR, FMB and village maps. Hence 0.12 Ha. only proposed for diversion instead of 0.36 Ha. authenticated.

Further the District Forest Officer has submitted that the proposed diversion of forest land in Compt.No.322 i.e., 0.12 Ha. does not falls in wildlife sanctuary area, National Park, Bio-sphere Reserve and Tiger Reserve. It is also submitted that there are no protected archeological/heritage sites/defense establishments or any other important monuments are located in the area and the proposed forest area for diversion is adjacent to NH-67. The crown density is between 0.2-0.4. The topography area is plain and hilly. The floral species are Narayepi, Maddi, Neeruddi, Yelama etc. and funal special noticed indirectly are Fox, Chowsinga etc. The District Forest Officer, Kadapa fulfilled the Part-II of the proposals and recommended the proposals.

Regarding submitting the certificates regarding under RoFR Act, the user agency has given undertaking and uploaded the same saying that the RoFR certificates as required will be provided during Stage-II (final) approval. It is also submitted that no violation was taken place so far. No CA is proposed as the area proposed for diversion is 0.12 Ha. which is less than 1.00Ha. As per guidelines NPV is exempted.

In view of above, the proposals in (5) sets, both in hard and soft copy in CD format are submitted herewith duly recommending the proposals in Part-III and submitted herewith in Parivesh portal for further process. The copy of the District Forest Officers reference 2nd cited is enclosed for ready reference.

Site Insepction: It is submitted that, after thorough inspection with reference to Gazette Notification, RSR, FMB and Village map it is noticed that, only Bit-I area i.e., 0.12 Ha is falls in Compt.No.322 of Gopavaram RF in Ramapuram Beat of Badvel Range and rest of the area i.e., Bit-2(0.19 Ha) and Bit-3(0.05 Ha) is falls outside Reserved Forest. The proposed forest area is adjancent to NH-67 and does not falls in wildlife sanctuary area, Natonal Parks, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve. Further, there no protected archeological/heritage site/Defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area and the proposed forest area is adjancent to NH-67. There are species of Narayepi, Maddi, Neeruddi, Yelama etc found in the proposed forest area. Most of the Forests is covered with light vegetation area has very light slope, hence there is no such vulnerability to the erosion. The crown density is between 0.2-0.4. The Topography area is plan and hilly. The soil is Red soil with Shale rock. The fauna noticed indirectly are Fox(Vulpes bengalensis), Chowsinga(Tetracerus quadricormis) etc. The user agency has given Certificate for No Tree felling in the proposed forest area on 18-07-2023.

Hence, inview of the above circumstances and after examining the Part-I proposals submitted by the user agency it is recommended to consider the proposals for diversion of 0.12 Ha in Bit-I area i.e., 0.12 Ha is falls in Compt.No.322 of Gopavaram RF in Ramapuram Beat of Badvel Range in favour of User Agency for laying underground optical fibre cable along the existing RoW between Badvel and Padamatinaidupalli Villages in favour of M/s Jio Digital fiber Cable private limited for providing 4 G communication in Kadapa District. Accordingly, the Part-II proposals along with the relavant documents has been submitted in Parivesh portal on 20-07-2023.
