Sub: - Proposal for Seeking prior Approval of GOI, MOEF & CC Under forest conservation Act, 1980 for Diversion of 1.8357 Ha. Forest Land for the construction of Srikakulam Pipeline (SAPL) Project of GAIL in Odisha-Diversion of Revenue Forest /Reserved Forest landUnder Ghumsur South Forest Division 1.8357 Ha.

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, the User Agency has submitted the proposal for diversion of **1.8357 ha.** of RevenueForest/ Reserved Forest land in Ghumsur South Division Srikakulam — AngulPipeline Project of Gail India Limited in Odisha the details of forest diversion proposal is furnished below: -

1. Brief Description:

GAIL (India) Limited, India's principal Gas Transmission and Marketing Company, was set up by the Government of India in August 1984 to create gas sector infrastructure for sustained development of the Natural gas sector in the country. The 1800 km Hazira - Vijaipur - Jagdishpur (HVJ) pipeline became operational in 1989. During 1991-93, three LPG plants were constructed and some regional pipelines acquired, enabling GAIL to begin its regional gas distribution in various parts of India.

GAIL (India) Limited, is India's flagship Natural Gas company, integrating all aspects of the Natural Gas value chain (including Exploration & Production, Processing, Transmission, Distribution and Marketing) and its related services. In a rapidly changing scenario, GAIL is spearheading the move to a new era of clean fuel industrialization, creating a quadrilateral of green energy corridors that connect major consumption centre in India with major Gas Fields, LNG terminals and other cross border gas sourcing points. GAIL is also expanding its business to become a player in the International Market.

M/s. GAIL (India) Limited envisages to strengthen local gas grid network in any state / U.T. of India via authorization by MoPNG. GAIL (India) Limited (GAIL), a Public Sector Undertaking (PSU) company

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is also one of the leading companies in the field of Natural Gas transmission pipeline. GAIL has taken a lead in developing energy transportation infrastructure and connecting major natural gas supply sources and demand markets. GAIL is first company in India to transport natural gas on open access basis and is a pure natural gas transmission company. The company has developed requisite expertise and confidence with proven project management competencies.

GAIL has been awarded authorization by Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas to lay a network of gas pipeline and associated facilities for the transportation of natural gas to fulfill the requirement of various consumers in the states of Odisha & Andhra Pradesh. The proposed pipeline shall be Bidirectional and pass through the states of Andhra Pradesh and Odisha. This pipeline would connect to GAIL's Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra pipeline (JHBDPL) at Angul and APGDC's Kakinada-Srikakulam (KSPL) natural gas pipeline at Srikakulam,

In view of this M/s. GAIL (India) Limited, (GAIL) has proposed to lay Srikakulam - Angul Natural Gas Pipeline (SAPL) Project including associated Spur Pipe lines under Authorization from MOPNG (Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas), Govt. of India. The approximate length of the SAPL pipeline is 690 kms with an initial system capacity of at least 5 MMSCMD. The said pipeline shall be passing through the various parts of Andhra Pradesh & Odisha for supply and distribution of Natural Gas RLNG to various industries and City Gas Distribution networks. Accordingly, GAIL has to start preproject activities immediately and pipeline is scheduled to be completed by 2022.

The proposed Srikakulam - Angul Pipeline along with spurlines will be laid across forest land falling along/ across the ROU (Right of Use) and various utilities such as roads, canals, rivers etc. The said pipeline shall be laid at the minimum depth of 1.2 mts. below NGL (Natural ground level).

The Srikakulam- Angul Pipeline (SAPL) Project is being executed in Odisha.

The present proposal is for laying of underground natural gas pipeline along with Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) from Gajapati to Angul (Odisha section). The Srikakulam-Angul Natural gas pipeline (SAPL) Odisha Section by GAIL (India) Ltd. involves 6.1487Ha. of forest land and 586.7539 Ha. of non-forest land passing through 286 villages in Odisha section. This BAPL Odisha section involves 08 forest divisions namely Parlakhemundi, Berahampur, Ghumsur South, Nayagarh, Khordha, Athagarh, Dhenkanal, Anguland 07 Districts namely Gajapati, Ganjam, Nayagarh, Khordha, Cuttack, Dhenkanal and Angul.

2. Justification:

The criteria for route selection are

- Optimum distance between source of supply and consumer location (demand points)
- Avoidance of Wild Life Sanctuaries, Reserved Forest, Mining area and Defence establishment to the best possible.
- Avoidance rocky marshy and low-lying areas
- · Safety of people and environment
- · Easy access to route during construction and operation.

The route was selected based on least disturbance to environment, forest, human habitation and aquatic bodies. It avoids National Parks and Wild Life Sanctuaries.

The selected route is optimized considering the above factors and connectivity between supply source and consumer location.

Common floral species noticed in the proposed diversion area are: Amba (Mangifera indica), Arjun (Terminalia arjuna), Bahada (Terminalia belerica),, Bija (Pterocarpus marsupium), Bheru (Chloroxylon swietiana), Char (Buchanania lanzan), Dhaura (Anogeissus latifolia), Dhoben (Dalbergia paniculata), Harida (Terminalia chebula), Jamu (Syzygium cumini, Kendu (Diospyros melanoxylon), Khair (Acacia catechu), Kurum (Adina cordifolia), Kusum (Schleichera olesa), Mahalimba (Ailanthus excelsa), Mahula (Madhuca indica), Tentra (Albiziaprocera), MuktamanjiMundi (Mitragynaparvifolia), Rai (Dillenia pentagyna), Rajmohi (Lannea coromandelica), Saguan (Tectonagrandis), Sal (Shorea robusta), Sidha (Lagerstromia parviflora), Siris (Albizzia lebbeck), Sisso/ Bali (Dalbergia sissoo), Sissooi/Pahari (Dalbergia latifolia), Sunari (Cassia fistula), etc.arenoticed in the area and no rare or endangered flora or fauna is noticed in this area as per Site Inspection Report of the undersigned at DP

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Wildlife Management:

There is nomovement rare / endangered/ Unique species of fauna in the area. Occasional movement of Bison, elephant, sambar, bear is noticed and Wild Pig is acommon wild animal in the area.

6.Tree Enumeration:

166(One Hundred Sixty-Six) Nos. trees above 30 cm. Girth are enumerated over proposed area of 1.8357 Ha. of forest land and 229 Nos. trees above 30 cm. Girth are enumerated in non-forestland total comes to 395 Nos. trees required to be felled for laying out of gas pipeline. Details of enumeration list is enclosed in Annexure- 15

7.Compensatory Afforestation:

The User Agency has submitted undertaking that the Compensatory Afforestation in lieu of forest land will be taken up in Kapilash RFof Sarangi Range, Dhenkanal Division, Dhenkanal. Further, the User Agency has submitted undertaking to pay the entire amount for Compensatory Afforestation in lieu of the total forest area proposed for laying out gas pipelines for Srikakulam-AngulPipeline, Odisha Project of GAIL.

8Cost benefit analysis:

As the proposal diversion of forest land is less than 20 Ha., Cost-Benefit Analysis is not applicable for this project.

9-NOC From State Pollution Control Board:

The User Agency has Applied for NOC to Pollution Control Board, for this Undertaking has been submitted by user agency .(Annexure: 25/DP)

10.-Certificate under Forest Right Act, 2006:

The User Agency has Submitted Undertaking to furnish forest Right Act Certificate.(Annexure-14)

11-Violation:

No violation under the FC Act. is reported to have committed by the User Agency as per Site Inspection Report of the DFO, Ghumsur South.

12-Position of displacement of people and adequacy of rehabilitation, if any:

This project involves no displacement for diversion of 1.8357 Ha.Revenue/ Reserved Forest land in villageKendubadi, Pangudi, Kholakhali, Golabandha, Bhetarsingi, Sankuru,Makarapalli, Nuapalli, Chancadapalli, Beluguma, Kumundi, Jatra and Chediapalli.

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13-Position of rare and endangered species available or importance of area from archaeological point of view:

No rare and endangered species are reported from the applied area. The area is not important from archaeological point of view.

14-Others:

- The basic information of Ghumsur South Division has been furnished as DP
- The User Agency has furnished undertaking to pay the NPV is enclosed in DP
- The User Agency has submitted the DGPS survey map along with shape file of the boundary of the forest area involved of Srikakulam AngulPipeline(SAPL), OdishaProject, which has been duly verified by ORSAC and duly authenticated by the DFO, Ghumsur South Division. As per DGPS survey the Revenue Forest area comes to 1.8357Ha.a copy of the DGPS survey map is enclosed herewith in DP

15-Recommendation:

In view of the above position, the proposal for diversion of 1.8357Ha.of Revenue Forest land in Srikakulam Pipeline (SAPL), Odisha Project is forwarded herewith in pentaplicate along with its supporting documents for consideration on its own merit and onward transmission to Govt. of India for diversion in favour of Srikakulam-AngulPipeline (SAPL), Odisha Gail India Limited under Ghumsur South Forest Division, Bhanjanagarin Ganjam district of Odisha.
