No trees required to be felled in this tract of alignment and required forest land is minimum and unavoidable. However, this alignment is selected and proposed for the project.
Aalignment-II	252/265	18X7.5= 120	0.0135	This alignment passes through maximum area of forest land. Therefore included forest area increase. Hence this alignment is not feasible and rejected.
Aalignment-III	252/265	20X7.5= 150	0.0150	This alignment passes through maximum area of forest land which is compaired to alignment I & II. And also these alignments in the straight way touch to the wall of factory. So that this alignment is not feasible for approach road. Hence it is rejected.

13 Specific Recommendation of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise the proposal with reasons.

The Proposal for Construction of approach road the forest area lies exact between the constructed industrial zone area and existing Talegaon –Chakan –Shikrapur road. There is no any other alternative non forest land available for propose approach road. The north side of Forest land and project agency's land is adjoined. We have inspected all other possible alternatives, but it is

not possible to avoid the forest land. The demanded area is barren & open forest. The required forest area of this purpose is only 0.0120 ha.

The demanded area is barest minimum and no trees are required to be felled. The area is to be diverted is not sensitive for any flora or fauna. The Construction of approach road will not have adverse effect on the ecology of the area. Hence proposal is recommended for sanction.
