- ❖ During the field verification by the Forest Range Officer, Luxettipet and me on 16.04.2021 of said proposed areas of diversion for construction of 500 KL ELMBER on Jalagutta (Hillocks) incuding approach road under water supply improvement scheme (Mission Bhageeratha) in favour of Dy. Engineer, PH Sub-Division, Mancherial.

❖ The proposed construction of 500 KL ELMBER an extent of area 0.0206 Ha on Jalagutta (Hillocks) involves approach road under water supply improvement scheme (Mission Bhageeratha) of length 932.85 Mts and 10.00 Mts width measuring to an extent of area of 0.93285 Ha., and installation of 600 mm D.I. pipe for a length of 396.01 Mts and width of 2.00 Mts measuring to a extent of 0.0792 Ha. which is passing through the Compt. Nos. 665 and falling in Rally RF of Luxettipet Range. The area has been calculated and the proposed diversion comes to be 1.0327 Ha (0.0206 Ha+0.93285 Ha.+0.0792 Ha).







- No alternative road is found to avoid use of Forest Land and also fragmentation of Forest Land.
- ❖ The area is having different type of vegetations, which is having 0.3 Density.
- ❖ In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree is found, no protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is found in the area.
- ❖ The proposed area is not falling in National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor etc. There is tree growth existing on the proposed diversion area.
- The distance of proposed area from Eco-Sensitive-Zone of Kawal Tiger Resurve is 33 Kms.
- The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project.
- The proposed diversion area is not falling in RoW.
- The proposed area is having prominent wildlife and frequent movement of Panthera pardus (Leopard) is noticed. In this regard the Wildlife mitigation plan is adopted.
- No violation of Forest Conservation Act 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency.
