
SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF/DFO

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

1. A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, HP PWD Dehra Division District Kangra H.P for diversion (under FAC-1980 of 1.5648 hectares of forest land for non -forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for Construction of link road from Masroor to Ghariar in Tehsil Dehra District kangra H.P. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 14.03.2022.
2. On inspection of the site it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest area measuring 1.5648 hectares.
3. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col.2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
4. Whether any rare /endangered /unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.
