

Site Inspection Report of Chief Conservator of Forests

The site was inspected by me on 06.09.2019 at 4.30 P.M along with Sri.Sudheeshkumar.S, Deputy Ranger of Konnakuzhy Forest Station. The proposed area is a part of notified Kodassery Reserve Forest , which was leased out to Plantation Corporation of Kerala. It is located about half a Kilometer from the Forest Station. The deviation from Chalakudy - Athirappilly main road is tarred upto erst-while boat landing area which is about two hundred meters in length.

The total area requested for the project is 0.1143 Ha. The proposal is for constructing a pump house, well, transformer and 450 mm pumping main. The project is intended to provide sufficient drinking water to the Kodassery, Athirappilly and Pariyaram Panchayaths of Chalakudy Taluk.

The site for diversion is devoid of any tree growth .The adjacent area are of oil palms forming part of the plantations of Plantation Corporation of Kerala. To the south of the site is Chalakudy river, to the North , East and West are the plantations of Plantation Corporation of Kerala.
