


Recommendation of Chief Conservator of Forests

Inspected the site for proposed water supply scheme to Kodassery, Pariyaram & Athirappilly Panchayaths under KIIFB. The total area of Forest land proposed for diversion is 0.1143 Ha. It is proposed to house a well , pump House and pumping main line & under ground cable for KSEB.

The area falls under Kodassery Reserved Forests under Kannankuzhy Forest Station limits of Pariyaram Range of Chalakudy Forest Division. It is on the banks of Chalakudy river (Vanchikadavu, the eastwhile boat landing area) which is free of vegetation but for some ground cover.

There is a small road leading to the proposed site passing through the land then leased to Plantation Corporation Kerala (the renewal of which is under process). The proposed project would not require any trees to be felled nor does it fall on the path of any migratory route of wild animals.

The project being one of great public utility and not impinging on the greater objectives of forest management, I am of the opinion that this may be permitted.
